- Second Chance Vineyard, Cawston, Similkameen Valley
- 28% Summerland fruit, Okanagan Valley

❖ Crafting

- All fruit and vines are hand tended, hand harvested, and hand sorted
- Sustainable, responsible, and organic farming practices
- Various small lot harvests in October (12th, 13th, 17th, 25th)
- Whole cluster, soft pressing for reduced phenolic extraction
- Two separate cold ferments in stainless steel to preserve aromatics and freshness
- Two yeast strains

❖ Tasting + Pairing

- Nose: Poached Anjou pear, dragon fruit, lychee
- Palate: Gooseberry, cantaloupe, pear, ginger
- Finish: Exotic candied ginger spice, long + fresh
- Overall: Wide mouth feel accompanied by fresh acidity
- Cellar: Chill + enjoy now
- Pairs: Fajitas, grilled cheese sandwiches, chicken wings
